

NOW THEREFORE THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Trust shall be known as "CENTRE FOR WOMENS DEVELOPMENT AND RESEARCH".
- 2. The OBJECTS OF THE TRUST AS FOLLOWS:

 a. To plan and execute sustainable women centered

 development programme for the Socially, Economically
 and Politically weaker Sections of the Community.

b. To work for the promotion and protection of the human rights of the women extenses. and the poor.

c. To take up Research Studies on Women's issues.

- d. To initiate $^{\rm E}$ ducational Programmes for the Process of sustainable womens Development.
 - e. To provide legal Resources/Legal Aid.
- f. To initiate actions for the protection and well being of children to uphold the "Rights of the Chiled."
 - g. To organise programmes for the Empowerment of Women.
 - h. Promotion and protection of the right to Housing of the Poor.
 - i. To enable the Poor Community to monitor the access and distribution of Public Services.
 - j. To develop and implement Community Health Programmes appropriate to the need of the Women.
 - k. To create an awareness about Gender issues.
 - 1. Documentation and dissemination of Data and information pertaining to Womens development.
 - m. To engage in advocacy and diplomacy work in defence of the rights of the poor.
 - n. To involve in Net working and campaigns for the cause of the womens development.
 - o. To Co-ordinate and Colloborate with other groups and Organisations in Solidarity for the cause of womens.
 - p. To create an awarmess about environment.
 - q. To organise lectures, seminars, Trainings, Workshops on matters and issues connected with women's Development.

- r. To emphasize the need of harmonious community life.
- s. To promote commercial activities that would augment the income of the Trust.
- t. To promote cultural activities that will serve to enrich the lives of the people.
- u. To provide relief to the needy in areas affected by Natural Calaminities and other emergencies.
- v. To all such other things as may be conducive to the development and attainment of the above objects or any of them.
- 3. The Office of Trust shall be situated at Present at 4A, C.G.E.Colony, Old Beach Road, Thiruvanmiyur, Madras 41, or at such other place in India as the Trustees may decide upon.

Branch offices of the Trust if deemed necessary shall be opened at the discretion of the Trustees at One or more places in India.

4. The Trustees shall hold the said amount of Rs.500/and all other funds, monies and properties which may
be received by them or accrue to the Trust hereafter
either by way donations, contribution and subscriptions
gifts, income rent, interests dividents or otherwise
howsoever and all investments representing the same (all
of which are hereinafter referred as "Trust fund) or trust
and subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and
declarations hereinafter declared and contained concerning
the same.

- 5. The Trustees shall get in and collect the income, interest and dividends of the "Trust Fund" from time to time and shall therefrom pay in the first instance all the costs, charges and expenses of and shall hold the net balance of the come and occupens of the Trust. Trust fund for the objects of the Trust hereinafter mentioned.
 - 6. For the purpose of carrying out the objectives of the Trust and for providing the facilities and undertaking the activities as mentioned above, the Trustees shall be entitled to utilise the funds of Trust as well as its income in such manner as they shall in their prodence and judicious discretion deem it proper.
 - 7. The Trustees shall be entitled upon to receive upon such terms and conditions as they may deem fit, donations gifts, subscriptions in cash or inkind and to collect funds by Public or private appeal for carrying out the objects of the Trust.
 - 8. For the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Trust the trustees are entitled to purchase or to construct one or more building or buildings, to to purchase other immovable property or properties, suitable for the function of the project. The trustees shall also be entitled to purchase or acquire furniture, equipments and all other movable properties as may be necessary or proper for maintaining and conducting the project and for providing the facilities and undertaking the activities at such places as may be decided upon and otherwise to give effect to the objects of the trust.

- 9. The trustees shall invest the Trust and its income as may not be required or necessary for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the trust in immovable properties, shares, debentures of companies controlled by the Government, Government securities, deposits in Scheduled Banks or limited companies with power to the Trustees to very such investments into other or others of the same nature.
- 10. The Trustees shall be entitled to sell by private treaty or by Public auction as they may deem proper any immovable property forming part of the Trust upon such terms and conditions as they may deem proper and benefit of the trust.
- 11. The Trustees shall have power to raise loans or obtain advances for the purpose of the Trust with or without security and upon such terms and conditions as they deem proper.
- 12. The trustees shall be entitled to let out its building or portion of the building as is not require for the purpose of the trust and also other immovable properties which form part of the Trust on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may deem proper.
- 13. The number of Trustees shall not be less than three and more than five, provided that if the number of trustees become less than three the surviving or continuing trustees shall been titled to act with the view to appoint trustees or trustee as to bring the number of Trustees to the minimum as herein provided.
- 14. The Trustees shall be entitled to appoint one
 Trustee from among themselves as the Managing Trustee
 with such powers and for such period and upon such terms as

the Trustees may from time to time decide. The trustee so appointed shall at all times during that period devote his or her, the whole time alternation to the various activities of the trust and deligently and faithfully emplay himself or herself therefor and carry on the same of the great advantage and efficient management of the trust. For the service rendered he or she shall draw a monthly salary and other perquisites as the Trustees may from time to time determine. The trustees shall be entitled be appoint one or more advisory committees to assist the trustees for carrying out the objectives of the Trust. Such committee shall consist of such number of trustees and other persons as the Trustees may decide. The other person to be appointed on such advisory committee shall as for as possible generally be persons who have a clear understanding of the implications and dimensions of the project in its totality and qualified to advise the Trustees.

- 15. The Trustees shall be entitled to remove and replace any number or such advisory committees or reconstitute such committees from to time.
- 16. The Donor shall be 'Financial Trustee's for the first time or till the period she likes to continue to work in the Trust in that capacity for promoting the finance of the Trust.
- 17. Every property movable or immovable shall be kept in the name of the Trust.
- 18. The term of Office of a Trustee shall not exceed five years from the date of her/his acceptance of the Trusteeship, provided however that she shall be eligible for reappointment as Trustees and the rightspowers and duties assigned to the existing trustees or trustee will also be vested in Trustees or Trustee jointly and severally with the surviving or continuing trustees or trustee. Every new trustee appointed as aforesaid shall have the same powers, authorities and sicretions and shall in all respects act as ifshe had been originally appointed trustee under these presents.

- 19. Whenever any trustee resigns dies or beformes insolvent or insame or is convicted of a Criminal offence involving moral trupitude ordesires to be discharged from or efused or becomes unfit or inceapable ofacting, then and in every ase the surving or the contrinuing Trustees or Trustee for the time being shall be entitled to appoint a trustee in the place of such trustees becoming insolvement or being convicted.
- 20. Every resolution or decision of the Trustees unless unaminous shall be taken by a majority of the Trustees presenting and voting and in the case of equality of vote, the managing trustee, presiding or the chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote. The trustees may pass any resolution by circulation if it is unaminous.
- 21. The trust shall be entitled to levy charge and collect such fees or subscriptions as they may from time to time decide for the facilities to be provided at each of its projects and for the use of and occupation of the rooms, auditiorium or any other part of its buildings.
- 22. The trust shall be entitled to frame rules and regulations for the conduct of their business and for the administration of the trust and for carrying out its objectives and for the maintenance provided therein and toalter amend or very such rules and regulations from time to time as they may deem proper. Such rules and regulations shall not be in contravention of the provisions of the Income Tax Act in this respect.
- 23. The Trustees may open an account or accounts with any one or more scheduled Banks in the name of the Trust or such other Trustees as may be authorised for the purpose by the Trustees for the time being with power in

the Managing Trustee or Trustees to operate the said account or with power to any two or more trustees appointed for the purpose to operate the same.

- 24. Proper accounts showing all receipts and disbursements made on account of the trust hereby constituted shall be kept by the Trustees and the same shall be duly audited with all necessary vouchers atleast once in every year by such auditor or auditors as the Trust appoints;
- 25. The Trustees shall have full power to compromise or compound all actions of suits and proceedings and all differences and demands and torefer any dispute or differences in orbitration and to adjust, settle and approve all accounts relating to the trust fund.
- 26. The Trustees shall be entitled to engage such staff and servants and upon such terms to remuneration and other connected matters as they may deem proper and to suspend, remove or dismiss any such persons so employed and to make provisions for the benefit of the staff by way of providend fund, gratuity or otherwise as the trustees may deem proper.
- 27. The receipt by the managing trustees or any other persons duly authorised by the Trustees for the monies paid in respect of the trust fund or in respect of any monies which may otherwise become payable in the trust for or inrespect of the trust shall effectively discharge the person or persons paying the same there from or from seeing to the application thereof.

- 28. The trustees for the time being under these presents shall be respectively chargeable only for such moneys as they shall respectively, actually receive not withstanding their respectively signing any receipt or receipts for the sake of confirmity and shall be answerable and accountable for only their own acts, receipts neglects or defaults and not for those of the others or other of them or for any Banker or other person with whom or in whose hands any trust moneys may be deposited or come or for any loss unless the same shall happen through their or his own wilful default.
- 29. The trustee or trustees for the time being may reimburse themselves or himself or pay and discharge out of the trust fund all expenses properly incurred in or above the execution of the trust of powers under these presents.
- 30. It is hereby declared that no benefits accrued shall ensure either directly or indirectly to the trustees.
- 31. The Trustees consider that the objects of the trust will be netter achieved if the income tax on the trust is exempted under the Income Tax Act. In case however, a particular clause of the instrument of the trust-in-adventantly clothed in language capable of an interpretation in confilict with the relevant provisions of the Income Tax Act granting exemptions, it is expressily declared that such clause shall have restricted meaning or null and void so that the relevant Income Tax act provisions will always have the oversiding effect.

32. The Trustees declare that in the event of desolution or winding up of the trust, the assets of the trust shall not be used by the Trustees but the same shall be transferred to any other trust, society or Institutions whose objects are similar to those of the Trust.
