To perform any other activities that are expedient for the furtherance of the above objects.

The Trust shall carry on its charitable objects without discriminating the Donees on the basis of Caste, Creed, Religion or Community whatsoever.

Provided however the Funds and the Income of the Trust shall be solely utilized towards the achievement of the objects of the Trust and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to Trustees by way of Profit, Interest, Dividend etc.,

**VESTING OF PROPERTIES:** The Properties and Assets of the Trust shall vest in the Trustees and their successors in office perpetually and irrevocably, for the fulfillment of the objects.

**INVESTMENTS:** The Funds of the Trust shall be invested in acquiring both Movable and Immovable Properties to increase the income of the Trust and those securities which are in accordance with the Provisions of Section 11(5) read with Sec. 13 (1)(d) of Income Tax Act, 1961.

8. **NUMBER OF Trustees:** The number of Trustees shall not be less than 2 (Two) and not more than 25 (Twenty-Five). The Founder Trustees for the time being shall have the power to increase the number of Trustees by way of nomination on the basis of the majority decision, taken in any of the Trust Meetings, subject to the maximum mentioned above.

9. **MANAGEMENT:** Mr. Akhaya Kumar Sagar shall be the Managing Trustee who shall be in charge of the administration of the Trust and who shall render proper accounts and do all such acts, deeds and things that are generally done by the Managing Trustee in the overall interest of the Trust. The tenure of the Office of Managing Trustee shall be for Life Time.

10. **VACANCY OF THE Trustees:** Any Vacancy of the Trustees that may arise due to reason of death, insolvency or resignation of any Trustee shall be filled up by the continuing Trustees by a majority decision and such Trustees so appointed shall be for the residuary period.

11. **REMOVAL OF Trustees:** If it is found by the Board of Trustees that any Trustee/Trustees is found to be working or involved himself working against the objects and interest of the Trust in any manner the Board shall have the power to remove such Trustee or Trustees by a 2/3rd majority of the members present in the Meeting called for the said purpose and the decision of the Trustees shall be final.

**CASTING VOTE:** The Managing Trustee who presides over the meeting of Trust shall have a casting vote in addition to his vote, if there is a tie in the voting on any matter or issue on which a decision has to be taken.

13. POWERS OF THE Trustees:

- a) The Trustees shall have power to acquire, possess, own, hold and enjoy all properties, Movable and immovable on behalf of the Trust, and to borrow, sell, dispose off, alienate, encumber, lease all such properties for and on behalf of the Trust and to derive income there from and to invest capital and income, as they may consider best, subject to the provisions of any law for the time being in force relating to Charitable Trusts.
- b) It shall be lawful but not incumbent for the Trustees to pay or discharge any rent or other outgoing charges, or payments in respect of any property held by them for the general purposes of the Trust and to improve, maintain or repair any such property and to insure the same against loss or damage by fire and defray the costs and expenses incurred by them in so doing out of the income or capital of the Trust property at the discretion of the Trustees.
- c) The Trustees shall have power to frame such subsidiary rules of business and shall have power to alter, add or amend the same from time to time as may be necessary for the conduct of their business not inconsistent with the provisions of Section 2(15), 10, 11, 12, 13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 with prior approval from the Commissioner of Income Tax.
- d) The Trustees shall have power to open a Bank Account in the name of the Trust with any Scheduled/Nationalized Bank or Banks and the Managing Trustee shall have the power to operate such Bank Account/s along with the other signatories.
- e) The Trustees shall have power to maintain and defend all suits in any Court of Law in order to preserve and protect the property of the Trust.
- f) The Trustees shall maintain regular Books of Accounts of the Trust, which shall be duly Audited every year by a Chartered Accountant who is appointed by the Trustees and the Accounting year shall be the financial year.
- g) The Trustees shall meet from time to time at least once in three months for the purpose of efficient Management of the Trust, to take collective decisions in proper carrying out of the objects of the Trust and all the decisions shall be taken by way of majority of the Trustees who are present at such Meeting.
- h) The Board of Trustees shall form various committees for implementing various objects of Trust as and when required and shall report their actions to the Board after execution.

14. QUORUM: The Quorum for the meeting of Board of Trustees shall be 2 Numbers. No quorum is required for a meeting adjourning for want of Quorum. A minute book shall be kept by the Managing Trustee. Minutes of entry into the office of every new Trustee and of all proceedings of the meeting of the Board of Trustee shall be entered in minute book and shall be signed by Chairman of the Meeting.

15. PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING: The Managing Trustee shall preside over all the Meetings of the Trustees. In the absence of the Managing Trustee, any Trustee may preside and conduct the proceedings at the request of all the Trustees present. All the Proceedings of the Meeting shall be properly minuted in the Minutes Book which shall be signed by the Presiding Trustee.

16. APPLICATION OF INDIAN Trust ACT: All the Clauses which are not specifically enumerated in this Trust Deed shall be governed by the respective Clauses of the Indian Trust Act, 1882.

17. DELEGATION OF POWERS: The Trustees shall be empowered to delegate the powers to any Professional Bodies, Committees or any other Person / persons, and take their advice as and when necessary for carrying out of the objects of the Trust in a more effective manner.

18. ACCOUNTING YEAR: The Accounting year of the Trust shall end on 31st March of every year or as amended from time to time.

19. RULES AND REGULATIONS: The Trustees shall be entitled to make Rules and Regulations for the Management of the Trust and all matters concerning Trust and Trust Funds and such rules shall not be repugnant to the provisions hereof or be inconsistent therewith.

20. AMENDMENTS: No amendments to this Trust Deed shall be made without 2/3rd majority of the Trustees present in the Meeting and without prior approval of Commissioner of Income Tax and no such amendments shall prove to be repugnant to the provisions of Section 2(5), 11, 12, 13 and 80G of Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time and rules thereon.

ACCOUNTS: The Trust shall cause regular Books of Accounts to be maintained of the affairs of the Trust. The Books of Accounts and the relevant records shall be got audited every year by a Chartered Accountant.

DISSOLUTION OF THE Trust: In the event of Dissolution or winding up of the Trust the Assets of the Trust shall not be distributed among the Trustees but the same shall be handed over to another Trust, Society or Institution whose objects are similar to those of this Trust and which are recognized Under Sec. 11, 12, 13 and 80G of Income Tax Act, 1961 and the amendments thereof.

23. CHARACTER OF THE Trust: This Trust shall be "IRREVOCABLE".

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
