

# POWERS OF THE Trustees:

- AMENDMENTS: No amendments to this Trust Deed shall be made without 2/3rd majority of the Trustees present in the Meeting and without prior approval of Commissioner of Income Tax and no such amendments shall prove to be repugnant to the provisions of Section 2(5), 11, 12, 13 and 80G of Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time and rules thereon.




